EXCERPT FROM THE MINUTES OF RECEMPCO's 18^{TH} VIRTUAL ANNUAL GENERAL ASSEMBLY MEETING 01 March 2024

Tagaytay Country Hotel, Manila

PRELIMINARIES

House rules were posted as to the time of registration. On line registration started at 8:00 a.m. until 12:00 p.m. Participating members were advised and encouraged to register early to be entitled to win in the raffle and avoid any network issues. Attendance form was required to be accomplished thru the link posted in the chat box. Likewise posted in the chat box was the link for voting where registered members casted their votes from 11:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. Alphanumeric code for voting was sent to the OPES of the respective participating regions.

The activity started at 10:25 a.m. with a Prayer, followed by the National Anthem, COMELEC Hymn and the recitation of the Cooperative Pledge.

It was followed by Atty. Adolfo A. Ibañez, on the presentation and acknowledgement of members. He emphasized the increasing membership of the Coop, especially with the expansion of associate members, with Luzon having 2,044, Visayas with 966 and Mindanao with 851 members. He further encouraged the members to actively engage and share their thoughts, emphasizing that their input is valuable for enhancing the Coop's services. The goal is to continuously improve and create programs that best serve their needs.

Atty. Adolfo A. Ibañez also expressed his gratitude to Chairman George Erwin Garcia for facilitating transportation for the Main Office members to attend the event through the ASD. He further acknowledged the Executive Director's approval of official time for the members.

As the founder of RECEMPCO, he shared details about the free insurance coverage provided to members of insurable age, for regular death and accidental death benefits provided by RECEMPCO which renewable annually. Then he facilitated the MOA signing with MBAI, represented by NATCCO MBAI CEO Ms. Minerva Quejada, highlighting that NATCCO MBAI is the fastest growing micro insurance company.

Followed by the presentation of the RECEMPCO Villa Project. He also presented the RECEMPCO Hymn, shared its background and creation process, and led the singing of the hymn.
